IMPORTANT MEMORANDUM

During the course of negotiations, we agreed to send a joint letter with a recommendation from your negotiating committee and the IBEW Local Unions that all job and reporting headquarters (as outlined in Article 7 of the Agreement between the Northwest Line NECA and the IBEW locals) should make every effort to provide a secure place for employees to park their personal vehicles. With the rise of crime throughout the Northwest, security of employee's vehicles has become a growing problem. The suggestion of both committees is for contractors to allow employees to park their personal vehicles in the same location that their equipment is parked as space allows and when can be accommodated. This may be fenced or unfenced as the situation provides. Contractors that are allowed to park their equipment inside of a utility yard or a fenced facility are strongly encouraged to work with that utility to allow their employees to utilize the same parking arrangements.

It is the hope of both committees that this will provide employees with the peace of mind that their personal vehicles will be secure while they are at work. We appreciate everyone's cooperation in making our industry safe for all involved.
